How to dispose of household waste and recyclable material in Sakado City

In Sakado City, waste and recyclable material are collected in four separate districts (District A-1, District A-2, District B-1, and District B-2).

Please check the first page of your district's Japanese version collection calendar for the days of the week to put out your waste and recyclable material.

When you confirm the day of the week, please put your waste and recyclable material out in the Sakado City designated waste and recyclable material collection bag.

Refer to the List of Main Waste and Recyclable Material, separate them, and dispose of them in accordance with the following rules:

The users are determined for each collection point.

The users are determined for each collection point. Collection points are managed by their respective users. Please use the designated collection points, follow the rules, and use them in a clean manner.

Please dispose of your waste and recyclable material by 8:30 a.m.

Waste and recyclable material put out on the same day are collected by separate collection trucks. Therefore, if waste remains uncollected, the collection itself may be completed. Please make sure to dispose of your waste and recyclable waste by 8:30 a.m. on the day.


Sakado City has introduced its own designated bags to ensure thorough separation of waste and recyclable material.




Sakado City designated waste and recyclable material collection bags are sold at supermarkets, convenience stores, and drugstores.



Put them in the case at the time of purchase or wrap them with newspaper.

*Bulbs, and electronic and alcohol thermometers should be classified as "non-combustible waste."

Electric cigarettes, electric shavers, cordless vacuum cleaners, etc.



Put into non-combustible waste outer bags and collection bags.

*If the battery can be removed, dispose of the battery on the day for "small rechargeable batteries, etc." and dispose of the home appliance itself without the battery on the day for "non-combustible waste."

"Used small appliances" means mobile phones and game consoles that are no longer used at home. Please put the 16 items to be collected into the collection box below.

Small home appliances to be collected (16 items)

•Mobile phones/PHSs (including smartphones), phones, electronic dictionaries, ETC in-vehicle units, fixed game machines, portable game machines, digital cameras, video cameras, portable music players (flash memories/HDDs), CD/MD players, VICS units, IC recorders/tape recorders

When you dispose of items at a collection point

Products for which rechargeable batteries cannot be removed should be disposed of as "rechargeable small home appliances, etc." Products for which rechargeable batteries or dry batteries can be removed should be disposed of as "non-combustible waste" for the product itself, "small rechargeable batteries, etc." for rechargeable batteries, and "dry batteries/lighters" for dry batteries.

Difficult-to-process items

(Items that cannot be collected and processed by Sakado City)

Tires, motorcycles (including motorized bicycles), car batteries, chlorofluorocarbon refrigerant dehumidifiers and air conditioners, medical waste (injection needles, etc.), agricultural chemicals, dangerous drugs, agricultural equipment, waste from the renovation and demolition of buildings appliances subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Act (air conditioners, televisions, refrigerators/ freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers), personal computers, and fire extinguishers cannot be collected and processed. When disposing of these items, please contact the dealer or distributor.

*Personal computers can only be accepted when they are brought directly to the East Disposal Center.

*Tires, batteries, and fire extinguishers can only be accepted when they are brought directly to the East Disposal Center (charge required).



Bulky waste

In case of direct delivery

Please bring it directly to the East Disposal Center. Up to 50 kg is free, and if the weight is over 50 kg, 100 yen per 10 kg will be charged.

In the case of door-to-door collection If you require door-to-door collection, you need to pay for it and make a reservation in advance by calling the dedicated phone number.

Up to five items can be accepted in one reservation (each item can weigh up to approximately 60 kg). Number and weight of items available for reservation

*If you will not be present on the day of collection, we cannot accept your request.

- *Please apply at least 3 days before your desired collection day due to the dispatch schedule.
- *Depending on the reservation status, it may not be collected on the desired date.

Waste that cannot be disposed of at a household waste collection point

(1) Business waste (waste from business activities such as stores, restaurants, and offices) cannot be disposed of.

(2) Bulky waste and difficult-to-process items (tires, motorcycles, car batteries, medical waste (injection needles, etc.), agricultural chemicals, dangerous drugs, agricultural equipment, waste from the renovation and demolition of buildings, air conditioners, televisions, refrigerators/freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers, personal computers)

(3) Please use the following methods for temporarily disposing of large amounts of waste from general households due to moving, vard maintenance, etc.

- Waste disposal method -

- (1) Ask a general waste collection and transportation licensee (charge required). (See below list of licensees.)
- (2) Bring in your own waste (see figure on the right).

*Please note that even if you bring in your own waste, we cannot accept difficult-to-process items. (Exceptions in some cases.) For details, refer to the "Difficult-to-process items."

When requesting the disposal of appliances subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Act, home appliance recycling vouchers are required.
