«Things to note when disposing of and separating garbage»

- Only garbage bags that are designated by the city will be collected.
- Unseparated garbage and recyclables will not be collected.
- The types of garbage and recyclables that you throw away on trash day depends on which district you live.
- Dispose of the "Specified item" on the "Specified day" at its "Specified location" until "8:30 am".

Q: How do I separate garbage and recyclables?

A: Check the "Sakado City residential garbage and recyclable material disposal procedure" attached separately.

Q: "When" and "what" garbage/ recyclables can be thrown away?

A: Check with the district where you live and check its garbage pickup schedule.
