

Sakado City Waste Disposal Guide

● Follow the rules to dispose of waste properly.

- Waste must be put out on designated days according to the category of waste.

Check the collection calendar for when to put out waste. ⇒



- Use the designated bags.



- Put out waste by 8:30 a.m. (Do not put it out the night before.)

- Put it out at the designated collection point.

- A sticker will be attached to any improperly disposed-of waste.

If you find a sticker on waste that you put out, please bring it home.



● There are 11 categories of waste. Please separate them properly.

① **Burnable waste**

② **Recyclable plastic**

③ **Recyclable plastic bottles**

④ **Recyclable cans**

⑤ **Recyclable glass bottles**

⑥ **Recyclable paper**

⑦ **Recyclable fabric**

⑧ **Non-burnable waste**

⑨ **Oversized waste**

⑩ **Fluorescent tubes**

⑪ **Flammable hazardous materials**



① Burnable waste

- Food scraps
- Tree branches
- Tissues/receipts



- Oil



- Diapers



- Shoes/handbags



Put it in a red bag with only other **burnable waste**.

② Recyclable plastic


- Bottles/tubes
- Cups/packets
- Bags



If dirty, rinse it clean with water.



- Food trays
- Caps
- Nets
- Styrofoam



Put it in a yellow bag with only other **recyclable plastic**.

③ Recyclable plastic bottles

- Remove the cap/label.
- Rinse with water.
- Crush.



Put it in a yellow bag with only other **recyclable plastic bottles**.

④ Recyclable cans



⑤ Recyclable glass bottles



Put **recyclable cans** and **recyclable glass bottles** together in a yellow bag.

⑥ Recyclable paper (Magazines, miscellaneous paper, newspaper, cardboard, cartons)

Separate by category and tie together with string.

• Magazines,
miscellaneous paper



• Newspaper



• Cardboard



• Cartons



⑦ Recyclable fabric

• Clothing, sheets, blankets



Put it in a yellow bag with only other **recyclable fabric**.

⑧ Non-burnable waste

• Pots/pans

• Plastic products

• Knives/blades

• Tableware



• Umbrellas/hangers

• Glass, light bulbs

• CDs/DVDs



Put it in a blue bag with only other **non-burnable waste**.

⑨ Oversized waste (cannot be disposed of at collection points)

• 60 cm or larger

• Bring directly to the East Disposal Center or make an appointment for collection by phone (049-288-5300).





⑩ Fluorescent tubes

- Put it in the box from the time of purchase or wrap it in paper.



⑪ Flammable hazardous materials

- Rechargeable batteries, rechargeable electronics, dry-cell batteries, lighters, gas canisters, aerosol sprays

Hazardous!



Put it in a clear bag with only other **flammable hazardous materials**.

- Do not mix with other waste.
(**There is a risk of catching fire.**)




Items to bring to the West or East Disposal Center (cannot be disposed of at collection points)

- Tires, car batteries, fire extinguishers, personal computers
- * A fee is charged to receive these items. (Personal computers are free of charge.)
- * Personal computers are only accepted at the East Disposal Center.



- TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers

- * A fee is charged to receive these items.
- * Purchase a home appliance recycling voucher at the post office before bringing these items.

Not collectable

- Motorcycles, gas cylinders, concrete debris, automotive parts
⇒ Contact the place of purchase regarding the disposal method.
- Waste from commercial establishments or businesses
⇒ Cannot be disposed of at waste collection points
